

## **Terms and conditions (Covid Revision 2 - 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020)**

Normal operating procedures (Covid revision 2) Fledgling classes F1, F2, F3.

Guidance issued by HM government and Swim England the governing body for swimming, swim schools and swimming pools.

“Subject to individual risk assessments swim schools should identify the potential risk to Staff and non-swimmers before resuming swimming lessons”.

- Guidance indicates that teachers should not be in the water when teaching.
- Guidance indicates that teachers must avoid physical contact with non-swimmers, providing support or assistance in the water.

Guidance is constantly under review. We do expect this to be revised and amended over the next few weeks.

However, until further guidance is published and in light of our progressive teaching style where two teachers are water based and in light of our risk assessments, we have decided for the safety and to rebuild confidence of the children, parents and our staff not to schedule F1, 2 and 3 classes.

We fully anticipate, guidelines will be revised allowing lessons to commence by October half term. January at the latest.

In the expectation lessons will resume in;

- Half term
  - Prepayments have been credited to your account and retained. Any balance for Autumn term will be requested and must be paid before we resume.
  - Direct Debit will resume in November applicable for the January term 2021.
- January
  - Prepayments have been credited to your account and retained. Any balance for Spring term will be requested and must be paid before we resume.
  - Direct Debit will resume in February for summer term 2021.
